



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to California Education Code 47605 and 47607, the Alameda County Board of Education will hold a public hearing on the **American Indian Public Charter School II's renewal appeal petition** at its regular meeting. At this time the public may speak to the renewal appeal petition or any other item listed on the Board's agenda by following the guidelines below.

- 1) American Indian Public Charter School II (AIPCS II) serves students in Kindergarten through eighth grade in Oakland, California.
- 2) AIPCS II operates as an Oakland Unified School District authorized charter and the school's current charter petition ends on June 30, 2025. AIPCS II's charter renewal petition was denied by the Oakland Unified School District (OUSD) Board of Education on December 9, 2024.
- 3) On January 2, 2025, AIPCS II submitted an appeal of the OUSD denial decision to the Alameda County Board of Education for a charter term renewal spanning the 2025-26 through 2031-32 school years (7 years).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Meeting of the Alameda County Board of Education (ACBOE) will be held on Tuesday, February 11, 2025 for a Regular Board Meeting with open session at 6:30 PM.
