Operations have slowed down in regards to training 2-5 week training conduit training basic electrical. Age range 18 to get on the roof. In class workshops 16 and older for electrical metal working. Course for graduating seniors funded through Americorp. They do assist in job placement.

Cary Roulet- CA. Caterpillar Tractor concerns gaps in fundamental safety training and understanding how to assess job related risk. Some students lack the mechanical aptitude, and fundamentals in safety. Interdisciplinary insight lacking in the overall general idea of how the world bolts together.
