Teapot cave



- 1. Red = Teapot Prow stand, V3/4, stand-start with high left-hand sidepull and right-hand crimp. Throw to lip and top-out on jugs.
- 2. Orange = Teapot Cave, V10ish, sit-start using a fairly obvious left-hand sloper/sidepull near the lip of the cave, and a very bad, indistinct sloping edge on the lip of the cave for your right-hand. Move up and right towards the detached-looking blocky jug, topping out easily from there.
- 3. Green = Milk & Sugar, V4ish, stand-start matched on the obvious block-jug above the Teapot cave. Move left, around the arete, and climb the left side of the arete to the peak. The lip of the boulder right of the arete is not used.
- 4. Blue = The Teacup, V5/6, sit-start using large right-hand sidepull jug, and good left-hand edge. Move up and left. Uses a huge foot out right, around a dab block.
- 5. Not drawn = The Teacup direct, V7, sit-start matched on the left-hand start hold of "The Teacup". Move up and left, directly into the finish of the original problem. This is a quite nice, logical way of eliminating the section of the boulder right of the big dab block (i.e. the giant right foothold on the original "Teacup").
- 6. Not drawn = The Teacup extension, V7, climb "The Teacup" until you can join and finish on "Milk & Sugar".
- 7. Not drawn = The Teacup direct extension, V7/8, climb "The Teacup direct" until you can join and finish on "Milk & Sugar".
- 8. Purple = Earl Grey, V2, sit-start in pit using obvious left-hand edge and right-hand on low lip of boulder. Move up and left, along lip holds, to the same finish as "The Teacup". (FA D. Anhorn, 2021)
- 9. Not drawn = Earl Grey extension, V5, climb "Earl Grey" and continue left to finish on "Milk & Sugar".
