

Backing up content is extremely important as we don't want you to lose any necessary content with the setup of your new iPad.

Not all apps backup content the same way. As a result, use the table below to find out the best way to back up content for specific apps.

App	Backup Method
Book Creator	<p>If you are done editing your book:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have audio in your book, export as a video and upload to Google Drive. • If you don't have audio in your book, export as a PDF and upload to Google Drive. <p>If you are not done editing your book: Export as ePub and upload to Google Drive</p>
Canva	Web-based; no additional backup needed
Canvas	Web-based; no additional backup needed
Capcut	Open video- Share icon (upper right hand corner- looks like an arrow pointing up). Choose Other. Choose Save Video. This will export to your Photo Library. Then, import exported video to Google Drive from Camera Roll.
Google Apps (Drive, Docs, Sheets, Slides)	Web-based; no additional backup needed
iBooks	Re-download from Self Service
iMovie	Open video- Share icon- Save Video- select resolution- this will export to your Photo Library. Then, import exported video to Google Drive from Camera Roll.
Notability	Backup with iCloud Drive: Video
Pic CollageEDU	Go to MyCollages- Open collage- Share icon- Save to Library- this will export to your Photo Library- can import to Google Drive from Camera Roll

Photos	<p>There are 2 ways to backup photos that are on your iPad that you want to ensure will be on your new iPad.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Upload them to Google Drive (and you will download them onto your new iPad)2. Ensure your photos are backing up to iCloud Drive.Video Directions
