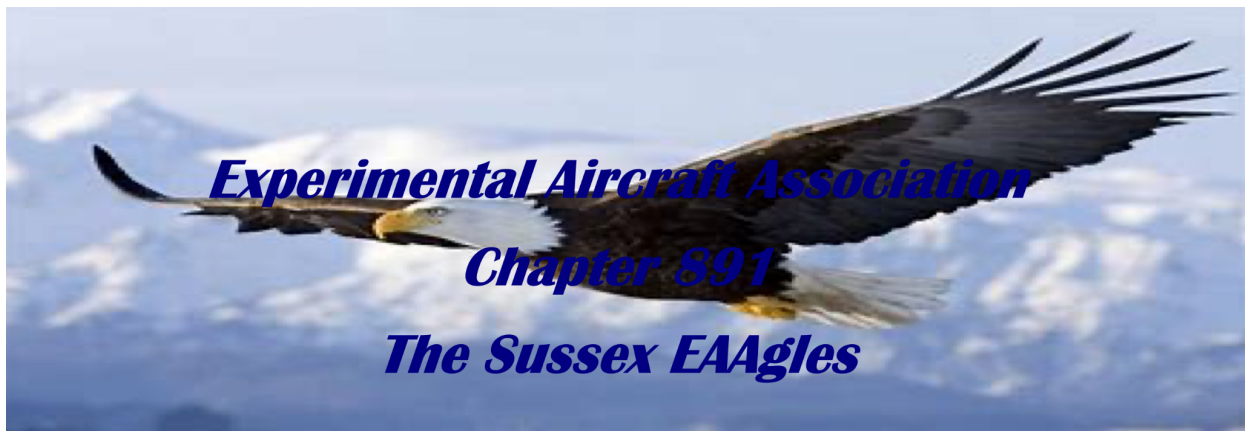




Meeting Monthly Digest
