- 1) Welcome
- 2) Introductions
- 3) AD Update
 - a. Sports are going along and teams are doing well
 - b. Oct 26 will be winter physicals
 - c. Heart screening will be Oct 25 for the 9th and 11th graders
 - d. Winter season starts with tryouts 10/31; accommodations are made for fall sport athletes—they must complete their fall season including CCS
- 4) Coaches update:
 - a. Boys Volleyball, Jeff Argabright: 25-30 kids have been coming out for open gym once a week getting more freshman coming in. Everything is good.
 - b. Girls Volleyball: 4/0 and getting ready for Pink Game
 - c. Cross Country: Varsity girls in league #1 (3-0); Varsity boys #2; JV girls and boys are also doing well. Tournament second to Bellarmine.
 - d. Badminton: Open gym – 40 kids already signed up so sport will have to be a cut sport next year. Leigh will stay in same league as last year.
 - e. Field Hockey: doing well; Varsity has had a couple of losses including Christopher and Gilroy but won today versus Del Mar. JV has also been doing well; had a recent loss to Gilroy but also won against Del Mar. One of the varsity players was featured on the CalHi sports network for her volunteer work.
- 5) Treasurer's report:
 - a. Year is going well; income is running higher than budgeted. Merchandise sales is going well and snack shack crushed it with the second highest night ever.
 - b. Expenses are at 24% of budget total with most coming from merchandise and snack shack supplies expenses.
 - c. Quick review of cash handling procedures; all cash has to have deposit form; all cash deposits must be counted twice and form signed; and if can't be deposited immediately then must be stored safely.
