Lesson Plans

Day One: Julius Caesar

- Open with overview power point on Julius Caesar
- 45 minute National Geographic Documentary on Caesar: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LqElPOyb-S4
- Read Act I and Act II aloud.
- 5 minute History Channel Video: Coroner's Report on Caesar: http://www.history.com/topics/ancient-history/julius-caesar
- Writing Task One: Why does Shakespeare choose to depict the life of Caesar as the life of a tragic hero? How does that conflict with what you learned in the documentary? ½ hour to write and email to teacher
- Complete Act I and Act II study questions.

Day Two: Julius Caesar

- Open by reading Act III aloud. Breakdown of themes in Mark Antony's speech.

 the Senate? Reflect on your mood as you heard the speeches and the tone created by each
 actor. ½ hour to write an email to teacher.
