## **BMP Description:**

Landcare is the primary snow removal service provider for the University of Minnesota Twin Cities (UMN-TC) campus. Landcare's snow and ice management process and service response goals are documented in the Landcare Service Level Standards and Landcare Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) on the Landcare website.

Landcare management staff meet regularly throughout the year to plan for the upcoming winter season. Planning tasks are tracked on the Landcare Snow Removal Tasks Calendar. Snow removal routes are mapped and assigned to staff equipment operators and contractors.

The policy does not cover areas where Landcare is not contracted to provide winter maintenance, including locations that are leased to non-UMN-tenants/operators.
