SEPTA (High School Transportation)

- Students at MaST in grades 9-12 who live more than 1.5 miles from school will receive Septa transpasses. Septa provides MaST with some routes (14, 20, 67) that come directly into our parking lot. Per Septa rules and regulations these are not guaranteed. Generally, tripper buses do not run on half days. Please ensure that your child is familiar with alternative Septa routes to get to school as the transpass is good on all buses on school days. Septa runs daily so missing your normal route is not an excuse for being absent.

SEPTA (7th and Up)

- SEPTA has two routes that pickup at the corner of Byberry Road and Roosevelt Boulevard (Route 1 and Route 14) in the afternoon. The drop off for these routes in the morning is the corner of Crown Way and Roosevelt Blvd., which is located on the corner outside of campus. Please ensure that your child is familiar with alternative SEPTA routes to get to school as the transpass is good on all buses on school days. SEPTA runs daily so missing your normal route is not an excuse for being absent.
- Students in grades 7 and 8 will be shuttled to the corner of Byberry Road and Roosevelt Boulevard via yellow school bus at the conclusion of the school day. Students in grades 9 and 10 can catch one of two SEPTA tripper buses, which will pickup on the north side of the building at the conclusion of the school day. Once the tripper pulls out of the MaST III lot, it becomes Route 14 and students are welcome to transfer at the corner of Byberry Road and Roosevelt Boulevard.
