Paraprofessional Services can be documented in 2 places in an IEP:

Accommodations and Modifications

- Program paras that are available to assist all students.
 - Paras in Level 3 or Level 4 Classrooms
 - General education paras
- Paraprofessionals that are assigned to resource rooms to assist all students who come in for assistance/services.

Child-Specific Paraprofessional Supports on the Services Page

All other paraprofessional supports will now be put here

- 1. Students on MA that receive paraprofessional supports for behavior and/or students with medical or cognitive needs:
- Personal Care Attendant: Level I Behaviors
- Personal Care Attendant: Activities of Daily Living
- Personal Care Attendant: Other Health-Related Procedures and Tasks

Always check with Amy Leonard (Maple River = Theresa Rome) to see if the student qualifies for MA prior to documentation.

- 2. Students with specific paraprofessional needs that are not being reimbursed through MA or heal/safety related they should fit under one of the following options:
- Behavioral Support: Three to one or fewer
- Behavioral Support: One to one
- Bus Para
- Job Coach
- Academic Support: Small group
- Behavioral/Instructional Support: Small Group
- Functional Support
- Other Options: Contact your Coordinator if this does not fit the specific needs of your student for additional drop-down options.

Para supports should be clearly described for each class or period of time unless supports are universal and throughout the school day.
