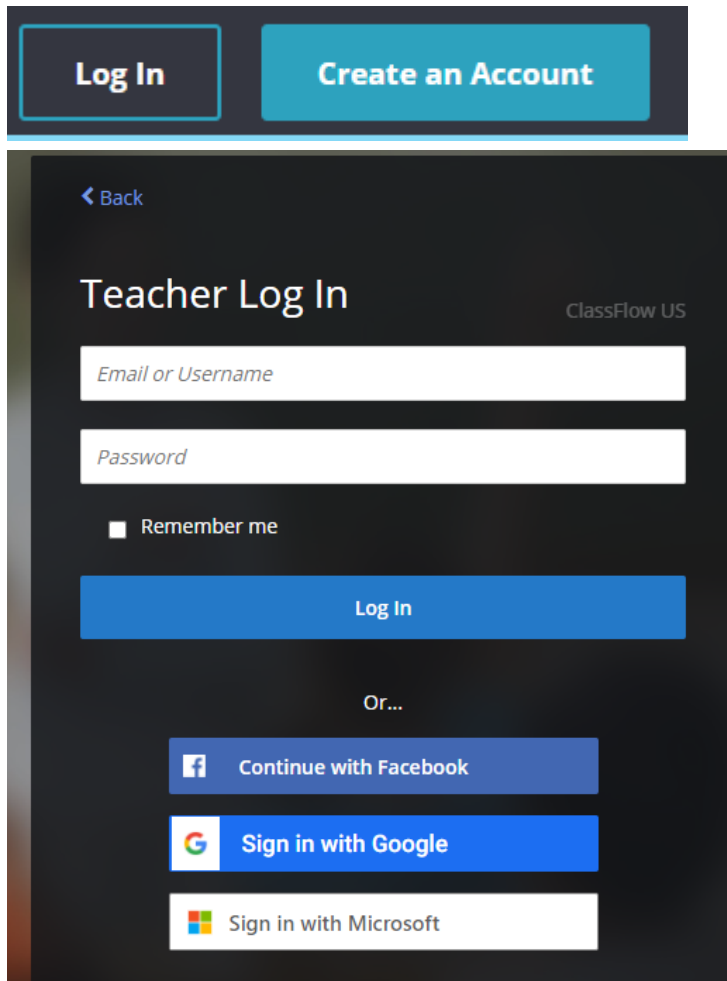

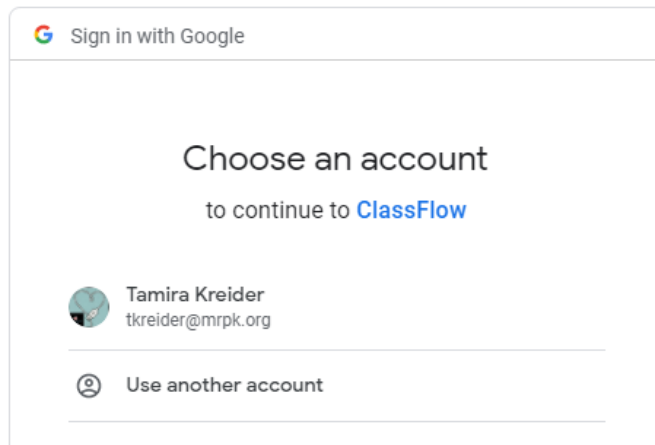

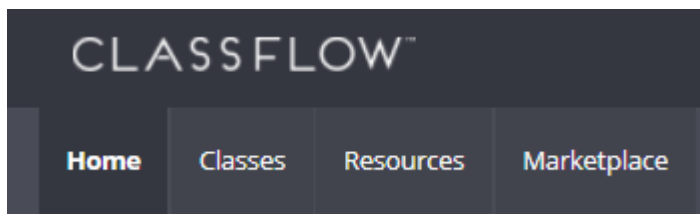

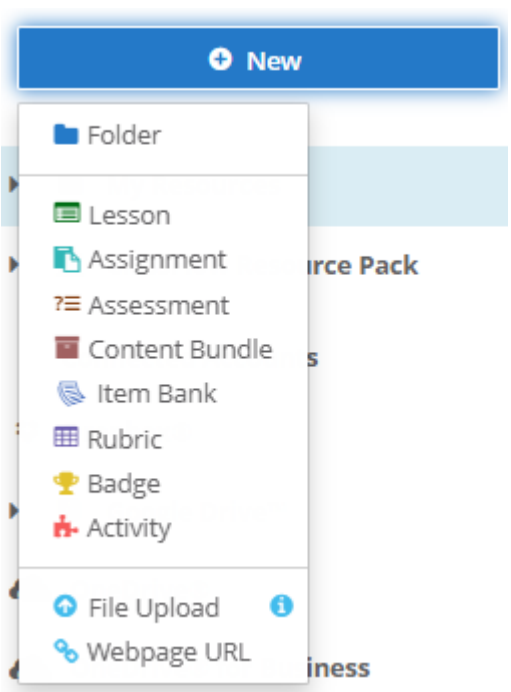

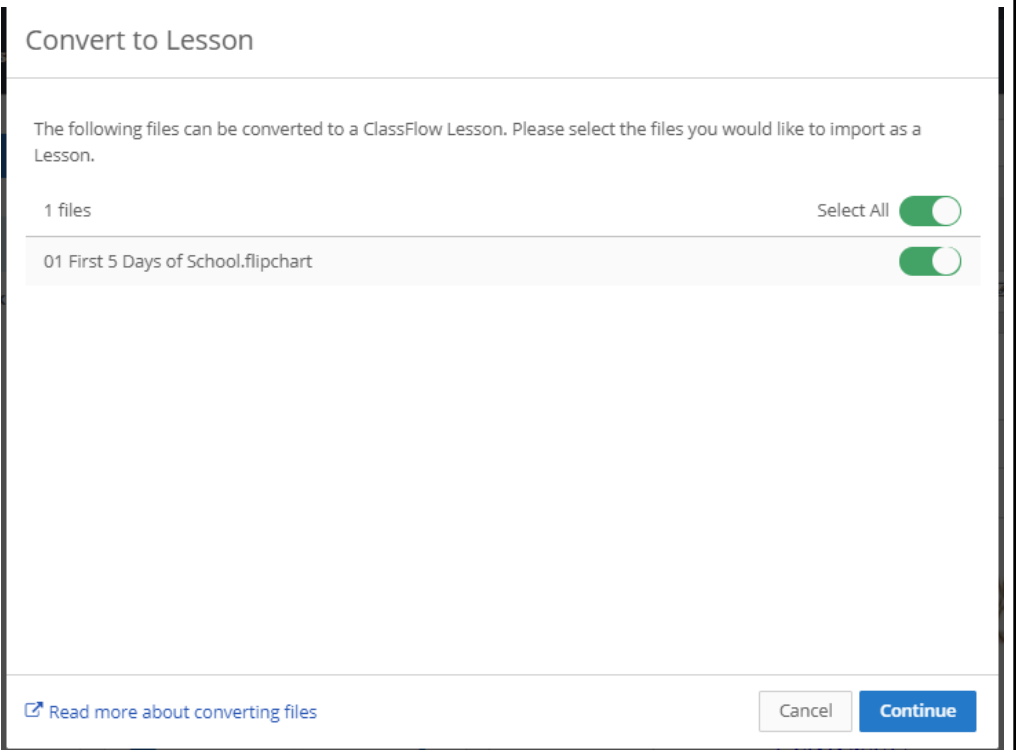
Click New and the File Upload

Your “flipchart” will now be located in My Resources on the left hand side of your screen. Click the dropdown arrow to expand.

You can use the toolbar across the top to edit the lesson or deliver to students either in class or remotely.
