MANHATTAN MIDDLE SCHOOL PTO - AGENDA September 15, 2025

- I. Call to Order / Attendance
 - A. Board members present:
 - 1. In person: Zoraya, Mercedes, Liz Pittoni, Kelly McCallister, Mercedes Hernandez, Kristen Lewis, Caitlin Fine,
 - 2. On call: Holly Williamson, Norma Ramirez, Aubry Hoffman, Tiffany Baczek, Jordan Martindell

 - B. Members Absent: Sarah Cottingham, Kristina Miller Olsen
- II. Principal's Update (Dr. Lewis):
 - A. Looking at list of teacher requests for Magic Phoenix funds. Total of all requests is \$300 less than what we had accounted for.. Looks like they will be able to fund everything.
 - B. Fallout from last week. Doing everything they can so kids have a normalcy during the day. Donuts were well-received on Friday.
 - One of the biggest questions after Evergreen: Can we practice lockdown during lunch. This Friday the School Safety Advocate will come in for a lunch-and-learn during both lunch sessions to discuss the process for lockdown in the cafeteria setting.
 - (Kerry John) Comment about lockdown at Fairview and Southern hills. A
 breakdown was that they didn't continue protocol until the end, and
 students didn't know when it had ended (not going through the whole
 loop). Dr. Lewis stressed that at Manhattan that they let everyone know
 when the lockdown drill is complete.
 - C. Good news, from SAC meeting:
 - 1. School performance framework came out Sept. 3. Manhattan is one of the top performing middle schools in the district.
 - a) Students with IEP: 2nd most
 - b) Students with READ plan: 4th most
 - c) Students of color (3rd most)
 - d) (Full details in report presented by Dr. Lewis)
 - 2. Performance plan slide
 - a) High performance is over 53%
 - b) 2023-2024, Manhattan, in the 50 to 60 percent range
 - c) 2024-2025, Manhattan at 77.4 / 100
 - d) 93rd percentile for ELA, in the state
 - 3. Dr. Lewis: "Manhattan has become an 'every student school"
 - a) 21.8 percent SPF improvement growth, Manhattan now at 77.4%. For comparison, Summit at 91.2 %
 - b) Among 19 middle schools, Manhattan is in top 1/3rd, maybe top 3 to 5

- 4. Question (Kerry John) about enrollment: last year 483, now 458. Most middle schools had a dip. Dr. Lewis stated that they're generally happy if over 450.
- 5. Question: How can you use and share this data?
 - a) Dr. Lewis, after 9/3 it's public
- 6. Question: Any issues with student teacher ratio
 - a) Dr. Lewis, not an issue now. Ratio is not equal in all classes, higher in some, lower in others. But overall in a good place.
 - b) Zaraya: working with counselors, try to keep under 28
- 7. Comment from parent (Kerry John): by January, start spreading the word, let people know that Manhattan is a great option for open enrollment.
- III. Chair's Update (Natasha Rigg):
 - A. \$63,955 raised for Magic Phoenix. Minus a few checks that have yet to be cashed. Goal was \$55,000.
 - B. You can donate all year long. Some people contribute on a recurring monthly basis.
 - C. Each teacher received a \$100.00 gift card at the beginning of the year. \$2,650.00 remaining to distribute. Currently looking at the list of additional requests from teachers.
 - D. Question from a parent if a request from a teacher was ever denied. No examples of denials. One example where a request was \$800. In this case, not able to give full amount, but able to provide \$500.00
 - E. Zoraya gave example of PTO funding book shelves and books for her class. In some cases chairs were requested and added. Emphasized that for these Magic Phoenix requests teachers need to stress what they need and why they need it.
