The novel “**Unanswered Cries**”

- Being in oppressive situation as a challenge to Olabisi, she decided to corrupt Pa Amadu so as to free herself from the situation.
- Female genital mutilation being an active agent of problems including over bleeding, STDs, and other birth complications, professionals like Dr. Asiatu Koroma conscientise the onlookers and other members in the court about scientific justification about the dangerous effects of the practice; hence, the banning of the practice.

The novel “**A Wreath for Fr. Mayer**”
