

Freshmen and Sophomore Open Campus Options

Starting in the 2024-2025 school year, North Royalton High School will allow freshmen and sophomores with parental permission to participate in the Open Campus program in a limited way. This incentive-based program offers flexible learning for students with strong academics, respect, and responsibility, allowing early release or late arrival under certain conditions.

Eligible students:

- Must have a 1st or 10th period study hall.
- Must enter and exit through the main entrance (Door #1) and leave unless meeting with a staff member.

Requirements:

- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 with no failing grades in the previous quarter.
- On track for graduation.
- Three or fewer tardies in the previous quarter.
- No disciplinary actions beyond 30-minute detentions in the current year.
- Up-to-date fees and registration information.

Students must leave campus during Open Campus periods. They must maintain academic, attendance, and behavior standards to keep their Open Campus privileges, which can be revoked at the administration's discretion. Parents assume responsibility for their child off-campus. The form serves as the application for the program, and schedules will reflect participation if criteria are met.

Students must apply using the form in their class Google Classroom.
