Dear Parents,

April 5, 2023

In order to mitigate the risks of forecasted severe weather threats to our area, Jay Schools are on a Remote Learning day, April 5, 2023.

During Remote Learning, teachers will be providing direct instruction “live” in their google classroom. Your child will need to access their Google Classroom for instructions, lessons, and to make connections with their teacher. Students can also email their classroom teacher if they have questions or need further assistance.

We are aware that students may experience disruptions due to weather and joining a class live may be difficult. The safety of our students, families, and staff comes first. If there is a tornado warning or signs of unsafe conditions exist for you or your students, we ask that you discontinue remote learning and take shelter immediately. Your child’s teacher may also experience some disruption in the delivery of content today and may have to stop the lessons on short notice due to the weather conditions in their area.

Please keep in mind that students will have five (5) school days if they are in grades K-2 and two (2) school days if they are in grades 3-6 to complete their assignments. Teachers will be recording their teaching sessions and posting the work your child is expected to complete on their Google Classroom. At all grade levels there may also be items in your student’s backpack that will support the online activities.

During Remote Learning, students with IEPs or 504s will continue to receive services. If your child has an IEP or 504, the special education staff members will be reaching out to offer support. It is a priority for us to make sure that students with an IEP are not receiving more work than other students. Their first priority on Remote Learning days will be to work on the goals listed in the IEP.

Communication between home and school will be critical during this time as we work together towards the common goal of providing a high quality educational experience for each student.

Finally, please know that the staff and administration of Redkey Elementary will be available to provide assistance if it is needed. Thank you for your support and dedication to your student’s education!
