WHAT TO BRING & HOW TO BE VAGUE ABOUT WHY YOU'RE BRINGING IT

We want for you to be able to communicate a few things to kids about the stuff they need to throw into their bag. We also want you to be able to communicate a few things to cabin leaders about what to throw into their bags too.

Stuff to Tell Kids:

- 1. Two sets of clothes (t-shirt, shorts, and closed toed shoes) that they don't mind getting dirty. Please don't tell them why, but this will be for our night 1 activity, along with a morning event on day 3.
- 2. **Beach Themed Outfit**. (Floral shirt, sunglasses, board shorts, lays, sunglasses, etc.)
- 3. Neon/90's Themed Outfit

Stuff to Tell Leaders:

- Volleyball Tournament We want to take a minute to stress the idea of bringing things that will help accent/enhance cabin unis, rather than bringing outlandish over-the-top things.
