<i>Virtual Best Practices</i>	Make sure you have a learning environment setup Please make sure you check your email daily for updates (this is an expectation) Please make sure you are logging into your classes and working daily Establish working hours and breaks for yourself (recommended 1-1.5 hrs per class but will vary by student) Remember if you have questions, please make sure to ask (there is no dumb question) Teachers through the virtual pathway are your first contact Please read all syllabuses Pacing Guides/course report (suggested) students may work ahead Student dashboard has the most accurate information, and genius is at least 24 hours behind schedule on the parent portal
