The B.S. in Kinesiology - Health and Exercise Science has three Institutional Learning Outcomes.

Institutional Learning Outcome 1: Know- Breadth and Depth of Knowledge: Students develop their understanding of the world with emphasis on Hawaii, Asia, and the Pacific by integrating: (1a. General education; 1b. Specialized study in an academic field; 1c. Understand Hawaiian culture and history)

ILO #1 Summary: A total of 97% of students are either in the target or acceptable range for ILO1. ILO1 focuses on students developing their understanding of the world and specifically Hawaii, including Hawaiian culture and history. Students demonstrate through KRS 113, 353, 354/L and 463 that they are meeting or exceeding areas such as general education expectations as well as their specific content knowledge for their academic field (Kinesiology).
