KEYS TO SUCCESS:

- ☐ Student attendance is critical!
- ☐ Teachers are available before school, after school, and during team-time if a student needs support.
- ☐ Students are required to use Schoology to monitor assignments and announcements.
- ☐ Parents/guardians should check Schoology to monitor grades, due dates, attendance, and assignments.
- ☐ Students **MUST** leave cell phones and Apple watches in their lockers and turned off – they are a distraction.

STUDENT WORK:

- ☐ Students should always arrive to school with a fully charged device.
- ☐ Work may be graded for completion or accuracy.
- ☐ Work should be neat, legible, and submitted/turned in on time.
- ☐ Work copied from another student will result in a zero for each student involved.
- ☐ Work generated with the help of artificial intelligence, like ChatGPT, is strictly prohibited and will result in a zero.

MAKE-UP POLICY:

- ☐ Students are **REQUIRED** to check Schoology during an absence.
- ☐ It is the *student's responsibility* to see the teacher concerning make-up work.
- ☐ Until the assignment is completed, a zero will be entered into the gradebook as a reminder and place holder.
- ☐ Each student will be given as many days as he or she missed to make up any assignment.
- ☐ If a student is present at school but absent from class (nurse, restroom, music rehearsal, sports, etc.), he or she is still responsible for all work assigned and turned in on that day.
