

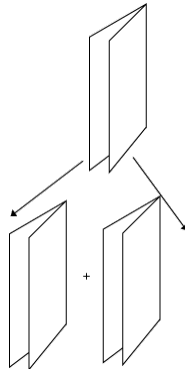
Escape from the 80s Set Up Guide

Puzzle 1 - The Toys

Print out **puzzle_1_toy_catalogue** on white A3 paper. Cut out each double spread and fold in half. Glue the white back together to form a booklet.

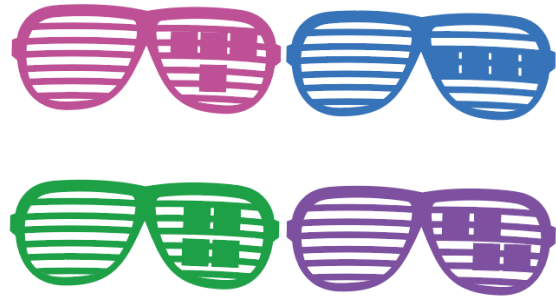


Print out **puzzle_1_escape_crossword** on A4 card. Cut out as close to the printed edge as possible.



Puzzle 2 - The Glasses

Print **puzzle_2_glasses** on A4 transparency or card.

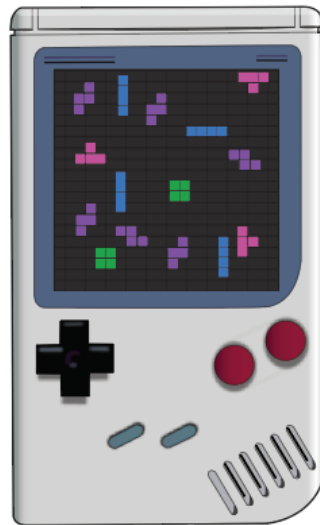


Print **puzzle_2_video_covers** on A4 paper.
Cut out as close to the printed edge as possible. Insert in blank video cases or wrap around discarded books.





Print **puzzle_2_gameboy** on A4 card. Cut neatly around game console border.



Puzzle 3 - PacMan

Print **puzzle_3_arcade_machines** on card.
Cut out neatly.

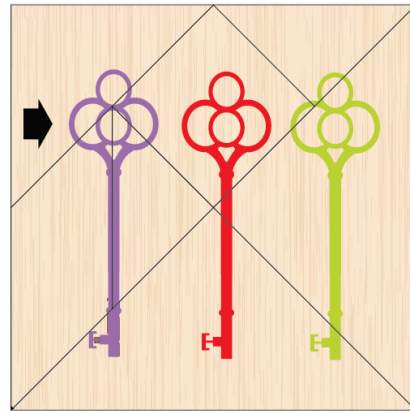


Print **puzzle_3_pacman** on card. Cut out
as close to the printed edge as possible.



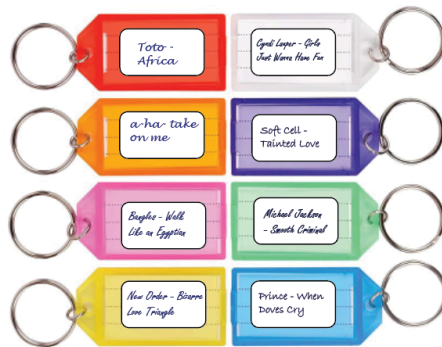
Puzzle 4 - The Keys

Print **puzzle_4_tangram** onto A4 cart. Cut each tangram shape separately.



Print **puzzle_4_key_rings** onto white card. Cut out each key ring individually.







Alternatively, use real coloured key rings, cut around the white labels and insert inside. Key ring colours must match the colours shown above.



Print **puzzle_4_cassette_tapes** onto white card. Cut each cassette tape individually.
