DEER ISLE-STONINGTON CSD BYLAWS

Organization of the School Board
Qualifications of Members

The School Board shall consist of five members who shall fulfill the roles of trustees and School Board members. Each member shall be elected at the annual municipal meetings for a term of three years by the voters of both Deer Isle and Stonington. The three-year term shall begin at the first School Board meeting following election.

The Chair and Vice Chair shall serve until the next organizational meeting, at the pleasure of the School Board. Removal prior to the next organizational meeting shall require a $\frac{2}{3}$ vote of the whole School Board.

The School Board Chair shall appoint members for the School Board to standing committees. Each standing committee shall elect its chair. The School Board Chair shall appoint members of the School Board to any temporary committees.

All committees shall be composed of less than a majority of the School Board.

Members shall be citizens of and reside in either the town of Deer Isle or the town of Stonington during their terms of office. Evidence that an individual is registered to vote in a municipality is *prima facie* evidence of that individual's residency.
