## **Spook-O-Ree 2025 Youth Protection Reminders**

Each unit must have two **registered** adult leaders 21 years of age or over on site during Spook-O-Ree.

There must be a **registered** female adult leader 21 years of age or over in every unit with female participants. If you are unable to provide a female leader, please note this on your registration. Your Scout may still attend but we need to place you with a unit with a female leader.

The BSA leadership policy requires that at least two youth-protection trained adults be present with youth **at all times**.

All adults staying overnight in connection with a Scouting activity must be currently registered as an adult volunteer or an adult program participant. Registration as a merit badge counselor position does not meet this requirement. *Cub Scout parents or legal guardians taking part in an overnight Cub Scout program with their own child or legal ward are not required to register as leaders.*

What this means for Spook-O-Ree:

- Units with female participants must have a **registered** female leader on site.
- Each unit must have at least 2 **youth-protection trained** adults traveling with them at all times. Spook-O-Ree is designed to be a "family" event and it is encouraged that adult partners travel with their Scout during rotations and throughout the event.
- Buddy System must be followed at all times:
  - Always single gender
  - Only be made between youth members
  - Adult program participants cannot be paired with youth
- In Cub Scouting ONLY, parents and guardians may share a tent with their family.
