

# Voter Information 2025 – Vote Yes on Prop 50!

November 4, 2025 is the special election and all California residents have the option of voting either by mail or in-person at a polling site. In this critical election, Californians will be voting on Prop 50, the Election Rigging Response Act ([read more and volunteer](#)).



## Important Dates:

Information from SD County Registrar of Voters, [www.sdvote.com](http://www.sdvote.com), 858-565-5800;

- ☐ **September 25:** Voter information pamphlets mailed / emailed to registered voters.
- ☐ **October 6:** Mail-in ballots begin to be sent to registered voters. If you have not received your mail-in ballot by October 21, call the San Diego County Registrar of Voters (858-565-5800) and another will be sent.
- ☐ **October 6:** Early voting begins at the Registrar's office (5600 Overland Avenue, San Diego, CA 92123), Monday through Friday, 8am to 5pm.
- ☐ **October 7:** Official ballot drop boxes open through Nov. 4. See [the list of locations](#).
- ☐ **October 20:** Last day to register to vote. If you miss this deadline, you can still visit a polling site and conditionally register and vote.
- ☐ **October 25:** [Select polling sites](#) open, every day 8am-5pm, through November 4.
- ☐ **November 1:** [Over 200 polling sites](#) open, every day 8am-5pm, through November 4.
- ☐ **November 4:** Election Day! Last day to mail-in ballots, drop off ballots, or vote in person. All polling sites open from 7am to 8pm.



## How do I register to vote?

- ☐ **Make sure you are registered to vote at YOUR CURRENT ADDRESS by October 20!** [Register to vote or check your registration status](#). *Note: your ballot cannot be forwarded to you. Make sure your address is correct for where you will be living in October.*
- ☐ **Same day voter registration is available!** If you haven't registered to vote by October 21, visit the [County Registrar of Voters](#), during the 14 days prior to, and including, Election Day - or a polling site on election day - to conditionally register and vote using a provisional ballot. [More information](#) from the California Secretary of State.
- ☐ **People aged 16 or 17 may [pre-register to vote](#).** You will need your California driver's license or identification card number, or you may print, sign, and mail in your application.
- ☐ **Review the state and local ballot guides.** All voters will receive the state ballot guide booklet in the mail (or via email if you chose that when you registered) in late

- ❑ **Mail-in ballots will be sent to every registered voter on October 6 and should be received within the week after that.** [Track the status of your ballot](#), and if you haven't received it by Oct 20, call the Registrar of Voters (858-565-5800) to request another.



## How do I cast my ballot?

- ❑ **Send in your ballot by mail by October 31!** We recommend sending your ballot **early** so it is counted on Election Night, rather than weeks later. **No postage is required!**
  - ❑ To be counted, your ballot will need to be postmarked by November 4 at the latest. It would then be expected to be received by the Registrar of Voters by Friday, November 11 to be counted.
  - ❑ Follow the instructions on your mail ballot to mark your vote. Then, sign and date the outside of your return envelope.
- ❑ **Drop off your ballot at a polling site by Tuesday, November 4!** Ballot drop boxes are open from Oct 7 to Nov 4. [See drop box locations](#).
- ❑ **Visit a polling site between October 6 and November 4.**
  - ❑ Early voting is available at the [Registrar's Office](#) beginning October 6, Monday to Friday, 8am to 5pm.
  - ❑ Select vote centers and the Registrar's office are open daily October 25 through November 3, 8am to 5pm.
  - ❑ Over 200 polling sites and the Registrar's office will be open daily Nov 1 through Nov 3, 8am to 5pm.
  - ❑ All vote centers, official ballot drop boxes, and the Registrar's office will be open from 7am to 8pm on Tuesday, November 4, the final day of voting.
  - ❑ [Find your closest polling location](#).
  - ❑ **Tip:** Mail Ballot Voters who decide to vote at their polling place should bring their Mail Ballot; if you do not, a provisional ballot will be issued but not counted until County officials verify you are registered to vote and have not already voted.
