Expectations & Obligations

1. Not all students are guaranteed to go to every contest (Due to Travel constraints).
2. If travel or contest spots are limited, students will be selected to attend by practice and contest points.
3. Students must be passing all classes in order to be UIL eligible for contests.
4. All students must be in good standing with the chapter, school, and an active member to qualify for each competition. Must abide by the chapters travel policy.
5. All Area/State teams consist of only 4 members.

Contest Attendance

Overnight Travel Contract

Conduct During Overnight Trips / Activities / Events

CTSO sponsors are responsible for all ____ISD students attending the activity / event / competition, and sponsors are responsible for ensuring student safety and appropriate behavior / conduct.

- Students breaking the district's, campus's, or CTSO's code of conduct, or violating the following rules on any school trip may be sent home at the parent's expense.
