**A God-Created Emptiness**

**John 7:37-38; Romans 16:17-18; Philippians 3:18-19**

John 7:37-38 – “deep within him” (CSB)/ “innermost being” (NAS)/ “out of his belly” (KJV), is the Greek word \_\_\_\_\_ = “an open space, a hollow, a cavity” = “an \_\_\_\_\_ that exists in our very being.”

Every person seeks, to some degree, to fill that emptiness and its longings with that which does not satisfy. \_\_\_\_\_

**Isaiah 55:1-3; Jeremiah 2:13**
