This course will provide students with the basic skills in reading writing and speaking  
in Hungarian at a post-beginner level

The course starts with **reviewing** the elementary grammar of the 40-hour intensive language  
program e.g. :

- Sounds and numbers
- Verb conjugation present tense – indef and def. conjugations
- Cases for nouns : Direct and Indirect object
- Locative endings

**New grammar** items to be covered during the course:

- **Past tense of verbs**
- **adjectives: comparisons and case endings**
- **auxiliaries / helper verbs**

Songs, nursery rhymes are an integral part of the course

**Course requirements:**

1. **Six 100 word essays**
2. **Final oral presentation** based on the material covered by the DVD Units
