Dear First Grade Students and Parents,

I hope you are having a great summer! School will be starting soon, and I am looking forward to a terrific year with you. I thought you would like to know some things about First Grade before you begin in September.

Your child's folder is a very important communication tool between school and home. Please be sure that your child brings the folder to and from school each day and that he/she shows it to you. The papers on the "keep" side of the folder should be kept at home. These are examples of work your child has completed in class or informational papers from school. The "return" side papers should be looked over, signed if necessary, and returned. Folders will be sent home on the first day of school.

A lunchbox is an important school item. Your child's backpack should be large enough to hold a jacket. Please mark these items with your child's name and class.

Students will be having Music, Art, Physical Education, and Library each week. We will have Physical Education twice a week and sneakers are required.

The first day of school is September 3rd, and Back to School Night is on September 5th.

I hope some of your questions have been answered, and you feel excited about returning to Taylor Street School in September. Get ready for a fantastic year in First Grade!
