Enable BIBFRAME in Your Institution

To enable BIBFRAME, one needs to <u>contact Ex Libris Support</u> and let them know which environment you'd like to activate BIBFRAME, sandbox or production or both. The Support Team will activate the Active registry for BIBFRAME work and instance, along with some of the URI indexes, including <u>Activate Key Fields Match/F50</u>, <u>FRBR/K50</u>, <u>and FRBR/K51 for BIBFRAME</u>.

Enabling the <u>linked data integration profile</u> is recommended for improving the accessibility of library data on the web. The linked data integration profile allows external users or Linked Open Data systems to access your library data, URIs to be resolved in the browser, and titles' permalink URI structures to be redefined. However, if your institution does not want the above mentioned features, activating this profile is not necessary.

Note: The BIBFRAME activation process may change in the future. The steps outlined here apply only to the current stage of implementation.
