General Assembly Feb 21, 2024 7-9pm Meeting Notes

Discussion in PRB

- Fencing for garden safety budget will be quoted this week by Jesse.
- Trash cans will be heavier, to stop them being used for doors.
- Humidity will be checked in the laundry rooms, if it is high, humidifiers will be installed.
- Signboards will be put in mailrooms for the delivery carriers.
- Camera coverage signs will also be posted to inform residents about the cameras.
- Survey to effectively use community space is being conducted, gym space, discussion going on to find space.
- Cycle stands can be used to locking down strollers by the residents.
- Spotty internet issue, residents need to reach STC to tell more about complaints.

ARA Report

- Programs and events are being planned, keep an eye out.
- RDs will be sending more communication to communities about the safety information.
- Residents should reach out to appropriate individuals, also use resident assistance line to know more and get help about reporting.

UCPD Report

- UCPD liaison Officer Ken not available for the assembly.
- Updates provided by Tiara: UCPD has a new official chief, goal to increase staffing for UCPD. Advertising is being done.
- Increasing signage for mail carriers, and cameras. Folks won't be under surveillance but this signage will help mitigate package thefts.
- Presence of security (CSA officers) in the community 24/7, instead of UCPD will be great.

UAS Management Report

- On March 6, in UV, Wash will install new larger units by removing other units.
- Residents are giving calls about parking. After hours also get the calls. Please kindly park at appropriate places. Officers will start patrolling again, so a reminder to community to be careful of these situations. Avoid Parking in other people spots and other garages adjacent to the building.
- David Wang: IT is not experiencing new issues. Please call STC if any new issues arise.
 Log is kept about every issue and we follow up with issue. Don't remove the equipment when you are leaving the housing, especially in Sepulveda and Keystone Mentone. - Report any latency issues, keep IT informed.

Public Comment

- AP: Facing issue with creating community event in single resident housing.
- We want to transport chairs and tables for the community event in Rose.

- Having transportation vehicles would be great, if any support can be provided by the staff.
- Email chain start by Event Coordinator, is it possible?
- Leslie: More discussion will be needed with house staff. If we can discuss about it in advance, it might be possible. Offline discussion will be better.
- Shivam: Is it possible to buy a trailer and tow the trailer on event days? Anyone with the car can attach and take it to the different places. Extra garage space will be needed.
- Leslie: We are short of garage space, might need to get more resident garage spaces back.
- Shivam: Possible to approach someone with empty garage space.
- AP: Need of budget and garage space will be important, it could be a long-term solution. However, for now, help with transportation with this event will be important.
- Instead of UCPD, safety ambassadors patrolling more in the UV might be a better option. Is it possible?
- TD: Will check with Sergio about it.
- Leslie: It is definitely under discussion.

Campus officers are excused.

AP: Reminder to officers. June is used for Year End review and transitions. We have less time left, please go through your by laws and join the general assembly.

- Please send us an email if there's something you would like to discuss.
- We should finish our by laws otherwise there might be stipend cuts.

Secretary

3. Reslife

UV residents want physical health and recreation facilities indoors (as per survey)
 Walkthrough for gym and possible mail storage room- Charlene will email for schedule.
 Ask in sawtelle second study room for fitness room.

Residents in the Survey suggested equipments but we have to select area (outdoor/indoor) to decide equipments. Send email about it to PRB group mind the power usage.

Cycle stands will have additional stroller parking space.
 What is the status? Maintenance Jesse: use cycle stand for stroller parking. Tiara: add more cycle stands. Check area in walkthrough.

- Do we have any other space for safe delivery? NO such plans. Using existing boxes.

Sepulveda resident in survey about pedestrian gate:

"Someone leaves it open regularly by unscrewing the screws. called the office UCPD about it they did not care."

"0.35y, 2-3 thefts, around \$400. Never reported because there are no cameras. Asked if anybody has seen the packages in group chat but no reply."

"1.5 years, 2 thefts, about \$100. Did not report to UCPD because they don't do anything."

Facilities and Maintenance

JA: Fencing contractor gave prices on Friday, will send the quotes.

Trash cans for laundry room. Found an option, there will be wall mounted trash cans. The custodians can remove the trash using the key.

Leslie: Some trash cans will be moved outside. Stone trash cans will be used.

AP: How will it stop people to move the trash cans?

Leslie: These trash cans will be extremely heavy. Enough trash cans available to put one outside each laundry room. 2 team members will move them since they are extremely heavy, they are also large.

AP: Other Points related to laundry room like ventilation, any updates?

JA: Vents are working well since the last time we looked.

AP: Residents reported the insides of laundry rooms are very stuffy/humid so they keep the doors open.

JA: We inspected the HVAC systems and they are running correctly. If every machine is getting used, it might be the case.

AP: Are there any plans to add anything else to bring humidity level down? Can the custodians check humidity levels especially on weekends?

JA: We can check the levels definitely on weekend.

AP: We won't be using laundry room for mail storage.

Residents informed the unsafe nature of this idea. Packages won't still be safe in the laundry rooms since the doors are still kept open.

Housing

- To improve the resource usage: Mail Boxes or Luxor, guidelines might be important.
- New delivery providers don't know this process, a signboard for the facility, "How to Use the Mailboxes" or "Don't put the mail out" can be introduced.
- Residents don't reach UCPD since people think there's no camera surveillance, and they are less hopeful. A signboard to inform residents and delivery people will be extremely helpful.
- Leslie: Campus Mailroom and Amazon discussed the delivery of Amazon packages. Will follow with Erika about how residents and delivery agents can be educated.
- Erika: QR code is a good idea. Will check the protocols shared with the mail carriers. Every mail carrier has unique code. It will still have to go through right channels and will need to be discussed.
- AP: Is it possible to get a concrete plan by next PRB?
- Erika: First priority will be to protect the procedures. More discussion will be needed.
- AP: In that case, simple information to the mail carriers to not leave the packages outside will still be important.
- Leslie: Camera coverage is available near pedestrian gates and mailbox rooms. However, there are no posted signs informing about surveillance.
- Signs can be posted near those areas.

AP: Why can't stone trash cans be kept inside?

Leslie: They might be too large for the laundry rooms. Best to put them adjacent to the laundry machines outside.

Kunal: People might bring issues about inconvenience of the trash cans being outside the laundry rooms.

AP: A particular resident has issue about noise, sent an email to housing. Do we have more information about the case?

TD: Some of the housing concerns go through Reslife. Team from Sepulveda might be handling the case. They might be communicating directly with the resident. Inform the resident that Reslife might be handling the situation with the resident.

Every measure/due diligence is taken before moving the resident to a new apartment since the emergency transfers are limited.

Charlene will email about the schedule for a walkthrough – indoor spaces conversion to indoor fitness.

AP: It would be a good idea to share about the needs of the community related to the equipment.

JA: Also think about the power for the equipment according to the space.

AP: Extension of cycle space to stroller parking space.

TD: Folks would need to purchase their own locks to put the strollers.

JA: We were not planning to buy any new equipment. Concerns about increasing the bike racks might come up.

AP: It would also be important to figure out how to inform people.

TD: It would be important to increase the bike racks. Program Managers might jump in discussion.

AP: Any thoughts to increase more delivery areas? Or will we just improve the safety of current spaces? Efficient use of mailrooms might be important.

Leslie: According to Erika, there are no current plans to bring more mailrooms.

Security

- Survey is ongoing, open till March.
- Some of the responses: Pedestrian gate is being unscrewed by someone on Sepulveda side. UCPD was called but nothing happened.
- We don't have the identity of the person.
- TD: It will be important to call resident maintenance line or housing.
- Liaison from UCPD (Officer Ken): New chief expressed desire to increase staffing to 100 officers. Bringing signage will be a positive step. Residents might be encouraged to report any sort of criminal activity. It will also act as the deterrent for opportunists. Potential of having security in UV 24/7, having CSAs 24/7 would be great.

IT

- No big issues. It is sometimes spotty.

- DW: Is the time of the day known? Or any other information. Make residents call STC.
