### PS 165 Town Hall

Scanlon presented an update on Leader in Me School Habit 6 is Synergize

Ms Rosado presented on Culture and Inclusion for April Cultural Heritage Month for April - Arab American Heritage Month Recapped March - Women's History Month and Civics Week

- -Kids created posters, learned about women suffrages movement and voted for a special song to dance to at the assembly, they participated in some art lessons
- -Each grade learned about a woman who shaped the world
- -Kids had an assembly

Ms. Scanlon presented information about the visiting 8th graders from Booker T Middle School

- -Booker T from 8th grade did read a louds with PreK to grade 2 students (with well prepared and impressive lesson plans)
- -Ms Scanlon will ask for this to be done again

Ms. Scanlon presented on Leadership Assembly

- -Happens once a month and is for quick school wide announcements and talk about the week or month theme
- -System of leadership points that results in class with most amount of points is awarded a trophy (4ft) that rotates that can be traded in for extra recess time etc

Ms. Scanlon presented on the Curriculum Overview Curriculum

Literacy- Fundations K-2 (early reading), Estrellita (Spanish Dual Language)

Heggarty- phonemic awareness (K-2)

Wit and Wisdom (kids like it), 2nd grade - Civil Rights

Math - Bridges (hands on learning), Number talks, exemplars - mental math and problem solving

Science - Amplify - projects

All teachers have same lunch and prep for grade and all base curriculum

Social Studies: passport projects in all grades

Curriculum is Modified in Dual Language ICT, GT (assessment and small group based on needs), ICT

Ms. Scanlon presented on Lighthouse Committee  $\ got\ \$250$  to figure out what they want to do

Ms. Scanlon answered a question from the survey on Gifted and Talented:

GT used to be an assessment given at age 4, DOE determined not as equitable so its transitioned

Its a rubric given to PreK children, its not academic based, its more about questioning curiosity and other things. GT does not mean a child is above and beyond grade level in every subject but has several qualities emphasized by DOE

ICT has 2 teachers and get more support for struggling

Ms Scanlon emphsized STEM Night! STEM Night - Wednesday March 27 3:00-4:30pm

Ms Scanlon emphasized how to foster Friendships across Programs and Grade Levels

- -Lunch and recess with grade as well as Special event is grade wide (trips, assemblies, shows)
- -Leadership roles include all programs
- -Cohort specials (4th and 5th) 1/3 of grade goes to the special (prep for middle school)
- -Older grades have class "buddy" in lower grade

Ms. Diaz presented upcoming DOE/Enrollment dates

- -Kindergarten offers Weds April 2 2025
- -Middle school offer April 9th

PreK offer may 13

## Ms. Scanlon presented about Mott Hall Updates

Mott Hall Proposal Went through - Mott Hall is leaving next year, not sure whats happening to space, Principal asking for the space, will update parents (maybe an extra kindergarten or PreK offering and build from lower grades bc hard to find older kids)

## Ms. Scanlon presented about G&T Application

G&T Enrollment - Application has changed, Grade 1 - 4th can apply to G&T through My Schools, Opens on April 21 and have until may 9 to apply, June 11 results to parents Based on report card grades and placement centrally through DOE (district wide program)

NY State Assessment presented by Ms. Diaz 3-5 ELA State Test April 23 - 24 Math May 6th to 7th Science May 13 (5th grade only) 3-5th computer based Afterschool 230-330 for 3-5th on computer, how to use the app

From Survey

-Are gifted and talented kids using the same curriculum as the rest of the school? Answer: Yes they do the same curriculum, all classes do

-State test how long do kids actually have?

Answer:

- -They can work until the last moment of the school day 2:15 2:20p (its usually not that helpful)
- -Kids can get rotated to an extra time room, get a lunch break but not recess break
- -Consider kids pacing when prep at home

What is the Executive Order to Dismantle Department of Education Answer:

- -NYC DOE legal team emphasized all policies stay the same
- -Not clear the impact just yet
- -Legal teams are working at NYC DOE
- -Principal will update
- -We will work together as a community to make sure
- -School gets federal funding Title I and 21st Century Grant

What can parents do about Executive Order?

-Continue to support your kids and be involved and contact PTA

When do results form School survey come out?
