1. Opportunities in the Volunteers in Partnership program:

(Due to the pandemic only virtual activities are available for the moment)

Activities with Community Care Networks: Community Care Networks was originally created for persons impacted by social distancing measures related to COVID 19.

- You can volunteer for telecommunication support (e.g., text, email, phone or video) which involves regular phone calls to reduce isolation, connect with community resources and build a connected community.
- You can also help out with the delivery of groceries or basic necessities.

Only english is required but french is an asset since some users might speak French

The application process involves a 10min interview and a 90-minute training by phone or video

3. Volunteering Opportunities with the Hope and Cope Program

Roles:

- Support cancer patients through varied activities and duties
- A lot depends on if the student is free during the day (and can help in a clinic or at the Wellness Centre) or is only free weekends and evenings (hospital visiting, palliative care visiting).

Some requirements Requirements:

- bilingual (English/French) is preferred but not required
- Commitment of 1 year is required (unless special arrangements are made with the immediate supervisor). You will only receive a reference letter after completing a minimum of 6 months of continuous service.
- You must respect you scheduled hours
- Must attend orientation and training sessions
- Must be willing to sign a Judicial Record Declaration form
