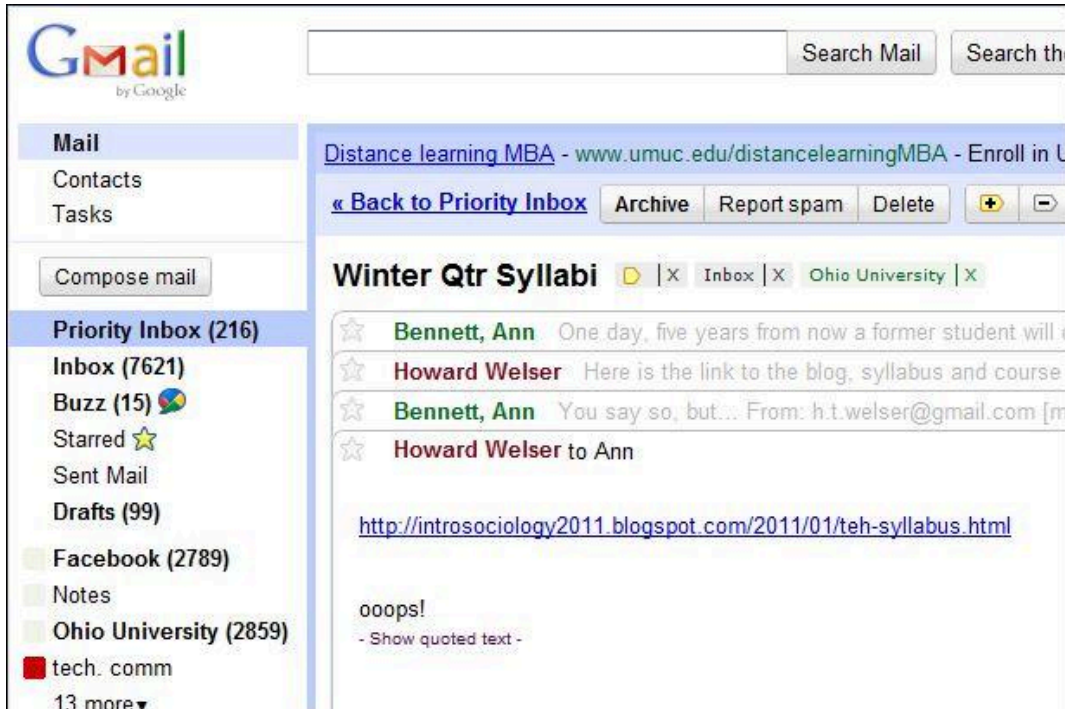
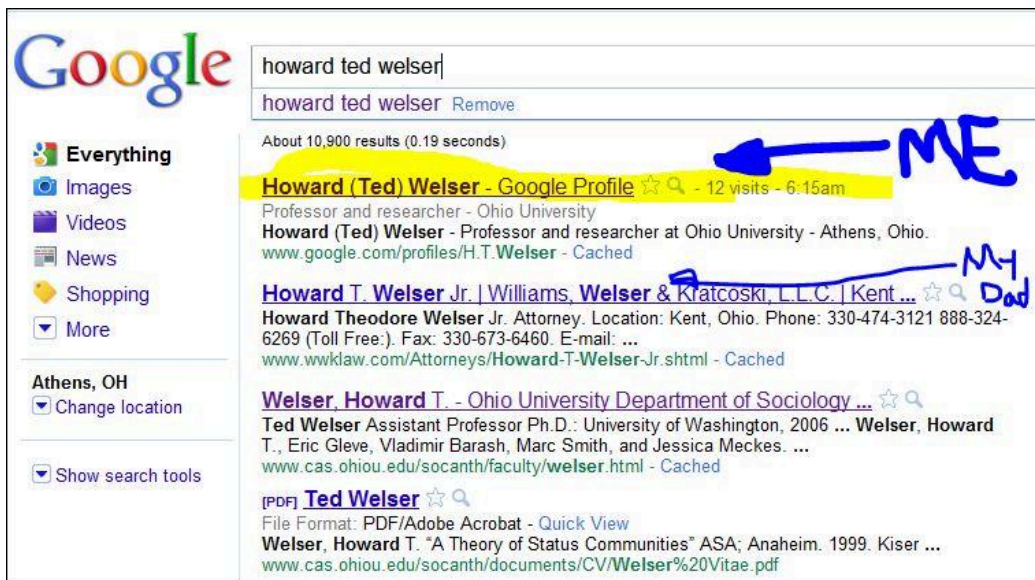


Three ways to find the course blog on a random computer:
