CLASS Courses by Child's Entering Grade Level

Entering Grades 1, 2, 3, or 4

Summer Ballet (1.5 hours) Grades:

Entering **1, 2, 3, 4**

Description:

Come dance with me this summer! Ballet is a theatrical dance that uses the body's movements to tell stories and express emotions. Ballet helps dances improve strength, flexibility, posture and balance while also developing confidence, self-esteem, and discipline. Miss Minnie has been studying ballet for over 20 years and has been teaching ballet for over seven years, with children ranging from the ages two to fifteen. In this class, Miss Minnie will be teaching the basics steps of ballet and how to dance with the music through fun movements games and activities. This class will also learn about the most famous ballets. But the fun doesn't stop there with the theme classes, where themes are created from music. Some of these themes include Disney, Taylor Swift and Hollywood Hits (music from famous movies)! We hope to see you soon in Summer Ballet!
