

Dixie Online Optimization Act

Whereas, the state of Dixie lacks any statutes mandating mobile-friendly viewing of government websites and applications

Whereas, mobile devices are far more accessible to the majority of Dixie's population than the average computer

Whereas, simple changes to government website user-interfaces make the lives of Dixie citizens vastly easier

BE it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Dixie:

SECTION I. SHORT TITLE & FINDINGS

1. SHORT TITLE

- a. This Act may be cited as the "*Dixie Online Optimization Act*"

2. FINDINGS

- a. The vast majority of Dixie residents own a mobile device
- b. A large amount of important government websites are hard to use or entirely unusable
- c. Generally simple UI changes can be made to better the access of the websites

SECTION II. DEFINITIONS

"Government websites" refers to all online sites operated and maintained by the Dixie state government

"Mobile-friendly" refers to a website being easily accessible and usable on a mobile device including easy form filing and general site viewing

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

1. All government websites are to be in a mobile friendly state within 6 months of this act going into effect
 - a. The Commissioner of Agriculture and Human Services is to provide the Dixie legislature with a report of the changes made to Dixie government websites

- b. \$500,000 are to be provided to agencies that require website changes with allocation being handled by the Dixie Chief Financial Officer

SECTION IV. ENACTMENT

1. This Act is to go into effect 1 year after passage
 2. Severability.—The provisions of this act are severable. If any part of this act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part which remains.
