Content	The focus of learning in this course is studying psychosocial concepts in nursing practice, health anthropology concepts, and transcultural nursing. Psychosocial concepts include self-concept, spiritual health, sexuality, stress adaptation, loss, death and grieving concepts. The concept of health anthropology includes discussions related to culture in general and in the area of nursing services, the etiology of disease in terms of culture and perceptions of health and illness as well as culture-based healthy responses to illness. The transcultural concept in nursing includes a transcultural perspective in nursing, Leininger's theory of culture care, cultural studies and the application of transcultural nursing to various health problems throughout the human life cycle.
