Dear Chariho Families,

State assessments are an important component of Chariho's Comprehensive Assessment System. These assessments provide information to measure the effectiveness of our curriculum and programs and identify areas where students may need extra support. Your child's test results provide information about his/ her progress towards being on the road to college and career readiness. Also, a qualifying score may meet one of Chariho's reading and/or mathematics standardized assessments graduation requirements, more information can be found on the district's [Academic Requirements for High School Graduation Policy](#) available for viewing on the CHS Webpage under Student Resources. The Rhode Island Department of Education requires that all students participate in the required state tests.

### **GRADE 11:**

Students in Grade 11 will participate in the computer-based (digital) SAT. This test will take place on **Wednesday, April 13, 2022**. The SAT and PSAT make-up date will take place on Tuesday 4/26.

Students in Grade 11 will participate in the Rhode Island Next Generation Science Assessment (RINGSA) on **Thursday, April 28, 2022**. The RINGSA make-up date will take place on 5/17.

### **GRADE 10:**

Students in Grade 10 will participate in the computer-based (digital) PSAT. This test will take place on **Thursday, April 14, 2022**. The PSAT testing make-up date will take place on 4/26.

A calculator is recommended for use on one or more sections of the math-calculator portion of the SAT & PSAT. Students should bring their own; however, the school will have some calculators available.

Students should leave cell phones and other prohibited electronic devices at home or in their backpacks as these devices are not allowed in the testing environment and possession or improper use of such devices during testing may result in disciplinary action in accordance with the school's Standards for Student Behavior Policy and/or test invalidation procedures.
