

Tight Lining MD:

SUGGESTED EURO NYMPHING GEAR

I get asked often about what would I suggest, what do I use, what is best, etc. At the end of the day, it is your journey and your budget. However, the goal of this document is to streamline the endless options and give you my feedback as a guide and professional. Here is what I use and what I suggest. Just remember, you get what you pay for and the “tiers” are there for a reason. There are differences in quality as you step up. I hope this helps you and feel free to reach out with questions.

What I own:

Orvis Clearwater Outfit 10'3 wt- A bit heavy/bulky for my liking, but serviceable and does the trick

Syndicate P2 Pipeline 10' 3 wt- My favorite rod for price point; paired with a Lamson Liquid. I use this all the time and beat it up. Both have lasted me over 10 years!

Cortland Nymph 10'6" 4 wt- Best “budget” rod in my opinion. I use this as a “jack of all trades” when I will be dry dropper, nymph, and streamer fishing. I pair this with a Lamson Liquid

Thomas and Thomas Contact 11'3" 3 wt- Best quality rod and my favorite tool for nymphing. Very sensitive and you can feel the quality, but expensive. When I am going to nymph all day, this is my go to! I pair this with a Sage ESN, the reel is a dream. This is my favorite set up, but I worked up to this.

**If I had to pick one for someone not wanting to break the bank, or just starting it would be the middle two. If I must pick one, and the budget was of no concern, it hands down would be the last.*

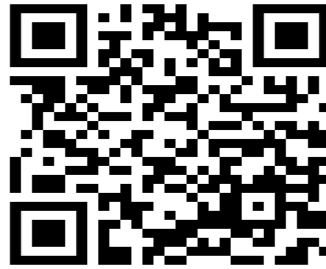
