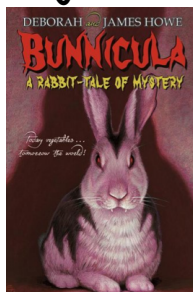


T.R.I.P. Project: Bunnacula



Subject	Activity
Reading (Choose one)	Comic Strip: Choose 6 main events from the story. Create a comic script using those events with captions. or Rabbit Facts: Create any model or representation of a rabbit. Include 5 facts about a rabbit.
Math (Choose one)	Animal Graph: Ask 20 of your classmates, family, or friends if they own a pet. Create a graph showing the types or number of pets they have. or Movie Expenses: Contact your local theater to find out the cost of a movie, popcorn, and a drink. Calculate how much it will cost for a family of 4 to attend a Bunnacula movie. Show all the steps to determine the final cost.
Language Arts (Choose one)	Mystery Story: The book <u>Bunnacula</u> is about a pet that is believed to be part bunny and part vampire. Create your own character by choosing an animal and a monster and combining them. Write a mystery story about the day you found your animal. or Book Review: Write a book review on <u>Bunnacula</u>. Include a summary of the book and your opinion of the book.
Science (Choose one)	Eat Your Veggies!: Create a poster promoting the importance of eating vegetables. or Dinner is Served: Plan and create a 7-day dinner menu that includes a meat, grain/starch, vegetable, and fruit. If possible, enjoy one of your meals with your family.
Social Studies	Lost Pet: In the story Bunnacula, the rabbit is left alone at the movie theater with a note that says, "Take care of it." Create a lost pet or a found pet poster of the missing bunny.
