

Alsager Tennis Club Coaching Notice to Parents/Guardians

To All Parents/Guardians,

Alsager Lawn Tennis Club takes the safeguarding of children being coached at our club very seriously and have adopted the guidance from the LTA (Lawn Tennis Association) which recommends that parents or carers supervise children under the age of 13 at tennis venues, especially during coaching sessions. This is part of their safeguarding guidelines to ensure the safety and well-being of young players.

Our Head Coach is LTA level 3 qualified and our junior coaches are at least level 1 which includes child safeguarding certification, enhanced DBS check (Disclosure and Barring Service) and emergency first aid.

If your child is under 13 years of age, you should be in attendance whilst your child is at our sessions.

Whilst most parents/guardians do this already we do understand that it is not always possible so what we politely request if you are unable to attend a session then you check in/out (your child) with the Coach to ensure that they are made aware. Similarly if you need to make alternate arrangements for your child's transport by another please let us know beforehand.
