ODE Requirements for PD	All teachers and administrators in buildings that serve students in PreK - 3rd grade	K-12 - ALL school personnel Training is provided by a building or district PBIS leadership team or an appropriate state, regional, or national source in collaboration with the building or district PBIS leadership team
	Region 3 Coaching Tip		The PBIS leadership team means the assigned team at the district and building level that plans, coaches and monitors PBIS. This team may include, but is not limited to, school administrators, teacher representatives across grade levels and programs, staff able to provide behavioral expertise, and other representatives identified by the district or school such as bus drivers, food service staff.
	ODE Requirements for PD		Parents and Families Districts must annually inform parents about the district's policies and procedures regarding the implementation of PBIS and the use of restraint and seclusion, including the district's complaint process.
