

# From RIDE: RICAS Family Portal

RIDE is pleased to announce that the new RICAS Family Portal is expected to be released on Friday, **October 10, 2025** at <a href="https://ricasfamilyportal.emetric.net/">https://ricasfamilyportal.emetric.net/</a>. The RICAS Family Portal provides online access to a student's individual performance data on the RICAS tests and will assist with tracking assessment information throughout the student's academic career.

Families will need to sign up for a RICAS Family Portal account using their students' SASID and date of birth. Each parent and guardian can create their own account, and up to three adults can add the same student to their accounts. Up to ten students can be added to each account.

To help families when the RICAS Family Portal goes live, schools should do the following:

- Create a process for families to ensure they know where to find their student's SASID
- Identify a staff member to assist families with questions

The following resources are available to help you distribute this information to families.



RICAS Family Portal Help Guide- A family help guide for creating an account and navigating through the portal is now available in both <a href="English">English</a> and in <a href="Spanish">Spanish</a>. The detailed help guide will walk families through how to set up an account, log in, and access the student and test information available within the family portal. This guide should be made available to families and is also posted on the <a href="RIDE website">RIDE website</a>.

Please note, the RICAS Family Portal is intended for family use only. Educators should use the RICAS Portal or the RIDE SDP to access their data and school or district results. Please contact the RICAS Service Center with any questions by phone (855-222-8936) or by e-mail (RICASServiceCenter@cognia.org). Standard hours are Monday–Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

# Fourth and Fifth Grade in SEL





In SEL at HMS, our fourth and fifth graders have started our MOOD Meter Unit! The mood meter is a tool students can use to understand their emotions and emotions of those around them. Students have started to brainstorm emotions that they have felt and organize where they could go on the mood meter. Check out the Animal Mood Meter below! We have introduced our animal scales. We use animal scales as a tool to help apply our mood meter knowledge and assess which animal BEST represents the emotion they are feeling that day or in that moment.




