### **Playground And Campus Rules and Regulations**

It is for the safety of our congregation's children that these policies have been created and must be adhered to the best of our ability.

We thank you in advance for your willingness to help do your part to keep our fabulous congregation a safe one!

#### **Playground and Campus Do's:**

- o Children are encouraged to run, jump, loudly, express themselves, and have lots of fun in the playground area as long as their behavior is in line with our congregation's covenant. The children must respect themselves, others, and congregational property at all times.
- o There will be at least one employee or volunteer in the playground area until the last child is signed out by their parent or caregiver. Children must listen to and obey employee(s)/volunteers at all times.

#### **Playground and Campus Don'ts:**

- o Children may not climb on the top of the yellow tunnel slide.
- o They may not push or pull others in any way, nor verbally show disrespect to another child or adult.
- o Slides are for sliding down - no climbing up slides.
- o Children may not climb our trees **anywhere on campus**. Our insurers will not cover tree related injuries.

#### **Courtyard Area Dos:**

- o They are welcome to stay in the courtyard area or choose to play on the playground. When in the courtyard area, they must walk at all times for the safety of themselves and others.
- o Children are encouraged to eat a snack, if they so choose. When they are finished with their snack or beverage, they are responsible for throwing their own trash away in a trash can.

#### **Courtyard Area Don'ts:**

- o Children may not run in this area. The playground is available for running or similar activities.
- o Children may not climb on the trees.
- o Children may not dig in the planters as it can hurt the plants.
