

## Enjoy CSE's large eBook Collection with MackinVIA

The CSE Media Center has a large collection (over 7,000 titles) of eBooks available for free through MackinVIA, an online program for browsing and reading eBooks. The state of Minnesota provides this collection to us through the University of Minnesota and Minitex. To access eBooks visit <a href="https://www.csemn.org/mediacenter/digital-resources-ebooks">www.csemn.org/mediacenter/digital-resources-ebooks</a> and click the MackinVIA icon. Use the username **csemediacenter** and the password **csereads** to login, browse, and choose from thousands eBooks.

If students would like their own account in MackinVIA, which gives them the ability to favorite books they want to read, make notes about books they enjoyed, request books to read later on etc., they should let their classroom teacher (or advisory teacher) know.
