



KNEU ON THE MO:VE

STIPEND PROGRAM —CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Within the program “KNEU on the MO:VE”, the University of Marburg (UMR) and the Kyiv National Economic University named after Vadym Hetman (KNEU) jointly offer a digital course program for students at KNEU in the upcoming term.

The aims of the program “KNEU on the MO:VE” are to enhance students’ digital learning experience, to make learning even more fun and engaging, and to offer course content and learning activities of high quality using the modern learning platform ILIAS at the University of Marburg.

Within this program there are three different stipend options available to KNEU undergraduate students who participate in the online courses offered within this program.

1. Students who participate in the program “KNEU on the MO:VE” can apply for *Online Stipends* for three months (01.10.2022–31.12.2022), with a monthly scholarship payment of 200€. This stipend aims at enabling KNEU students to continue their studies remotely, even in the currently difficult circumstances.
2. Students who are in their third or fourth year of studies can apply for a one-month *Mobility Stipend* (861€ plus 350€ to cover traveling costs) associated with a short stay in Marburg in November or December 2022. This stipend aims at granting KNEU students, who are in the final phase of their undergraduate studies and want to use the stay at the University of Marburg for their thesis research and/or to inform themselves about available Master degree courses.
3. Students who are in their third or fourth year of studies can also combine the first two options and apply for the *Online + Mobility Stipend*. In this case the online stipend of 200€ per month is only paid for 2 months, with the third month being replaced by the mobility stipend as outlined in option 2.

The number of available stipends is limited, and a high priority will be given to those applicants who continue their studies in particularly adverse conditions. Moreover, stipends will be awarded on the basis of academic achievements.
