NCAA Eligibility & Academic Progression

During the 2024–2025 academic year, several online course segments were later determined not to meet NCAA approval requirements for core-course eligibility. In addition, an AP Government & Politics course counted for 0.5 credit rather than the full credit originally anticipated.

As a result, Jack strategically adjusted his graduation timeline from the Class of 2027 to the Class of 2028 in order to maintain a rigorous academic pathway while preserving balance between academics, year-round baseball development, and part-time employment responsibilities.

Rather than doubling up on core academic coursework, he shifted several elective-focused courses into his additional academic year, allowing him to focus on NCAA-approved core-course progression and continue pursuing advanced coursework, honors classes, and planned dual-enrollment college classes in a sustainable and organized manner.

This adjustment was administrative and eligibility-related rather than performance-related, and reflects a long-term academic and athletic planning decision focused on both NCAA readiness and continued personal development.
