Below are links to content that staff will use throughout the school year to access professional development content. The goal for the school year is to provide staff the freedom to perform this professional development at a time that works best for them. Time will be built into the school year during In-service days and Flyer Fridays. The concept of flexible professional development is to give staff the flexibility to complete professional development activities during this time, or leave and perform the professional development activities at a different time in the future.
