The fourth meeting of the Erasmus+ (KA229) project “GO GREEN” was held from the 25th September 2022 to the 2nd October 2022 in Sofia, Bulgaria.

The Czech delegation from Střední odborná škola ochrany osob a majetku s.r.o. arrived in Sofia on the 29th of September and left 2nd of October. The delegation consisted of the project coordinator Mr. Michal Florek, the teacher Mr. Antonín Prokeš and students Mr. Jan Luboš Váňa, Mr. Dalibor Vaněk and Mr. Maxmilián Číž.

The Portuguese delegation from Agrupamento de Escolas Alberto Sampaio arrived in Sofia on the 25th of September and left on the 2nd of October. The delegation consisted of teachers Ms. Paula Alexandra de Carvalho Sobral Gomes, Ms. Vania Betina da Costa Pereira Coutinho and students Ms. Beatriz Sofia Gomes da Silva, Ms. Filipa Santos Marques and Ms. Hillary Alexandra Arroyo Marques Valencia.

The Greek delegation from 1o Imerisio Geniko Lykeio Karditsas arrived in Sofia on the 25th of September and left on the 2nd of October. The delegation consisted of teachers Ms. Sophia Briana, Ms. Chara Mitrogogou Tsiotsiou and students Ms. Galani Eleni, Ms. Ntantami Vasiliki and Ms. Daniil Maria.

The Spanish delegation from INS Monstsacopa arrived in Sofia on the 25th of September and left on the 2nd of October. The delegation consisted of the teachers Ms. Maria Galizia Amoraga, Ms. Veronika Galindo Gomez and students Mr. Biel Serrat Cortada, Mr. Guillem Soler Ros, Mr. Pere Lort Juanola and Mr. Pol Janoher Pujol.

The Turkish delegation from TED Antalya Özel Lisesi arrived in Sofia on the 25th of September and left on the 1st of October. The delegation consisted of the teachers Ms. Dila Delfin Seren, Ms. Fatma Kara and students Ms. Asli Dogramaci and Ms. Gözde Kaplan.

On sunday 25th September, participants from the Czech republic, Portugal, Greece, Spain and Turkey were welcomed by the teachers of the host country and then moved to the hotel.

On monday 26th September, all the participants were taken by bus to the host school where a welcome ceremony was held by the school principal consisted the traditional bulgarian dances.

After the welcoming ceremony, the Bulgarian students gave information about the bulgarian education system and the seminări about „forests in our towns“ was prepared.

After welcome ceremony were all the partners taken to the tour the school classes where the host school showed to the others how the classic classes and playground look like. Participants were taken to also chemistry class especially because the host school is chemistry oriented. Meanwhile students had a ice-breaking activity the teachers had a teachers meeting.

Afterwards, a national cuisine day was prepared in the project class. All partners presented their local snacks, sweets, biscuits and meals. As our cultures are different and each country has different rules when it comes to food, the leaders of the partner school informed all participants about food composting.

National cuisine day was followed by the tour of the city. All the partners were taken by bus to the Sofia city center, where students and teachers were introduced to the history of the Sofia city and visited the city town hall and local council.

In the evening all the participants were moved to the hotel and went to take dinner to the restaurant.

On tuesday 27th September, all the participants were taken by bus around 8:30 to whole day trip to Lukovit - Iskar - Panega Geopark. The lunch was organized in the middle of trip.

As first, all the participants seen “stone houses” in Lukovit village, the Prohodna cave followed - which is known as a “god eyes” and after were all the partners moved to Golden Park Lukovit.

All the participants arrived back to the hotel around 18:00 and went to take a dinner to restaurant.

On wednesday 28th September, all the participants were taken by bus at 8:30 for a trip to have a sightseeing tour of Rila monastery (most famous Eastern Orthodox monastery in Bulgaria).

After the visiting Rila monastery were all the participants taken to Blagoevgrad for a visiting national park Bachinovo.

All the participants arrived back to the hotel around 17:00 and went to take a dinner to restaurant.

On Thursday 29th September, all the participants were taken by bus at 8:30 for visiting a private botanical garden. All the participants were introduced by the owner how to take care about the botanical garden in Borika city. All the partners had the opportunity to explore plants and flora from all over the world growing in that garden.

After the botanical garden were all the participants taken by bus to Old Plovdiv city where was a guided tour by host school and the partners could rest in the historical part of the city.

On Friday 30th September, all the partners were taken by bus to the Forestry University, where the workshop and presentation about „water polution and analyzing water“ was presented by the professors from the University. Participants visited also the laboratory with the insect from the whole europe and got the presentation about that. After the lunch in school canteen the forest leafs game was prepared for the students in the park in front of the university.

Because of the leaving Turkish partners on Saturday (they didn't have good flight connection on Sunday), the farewell diner was organised in the hotels representative hall where was the certificate ceremony organised.

On Satudray 1st September, were all the participants without the Turkish team taken by local bus to Vitosha mountains for a walk trip and Bulgarians students gave information about the history of Vitosha. Unfortunately the weather wasn't on our side and the rain moved us back to the hotel earlier.

All the participants got a time to prepare for a morning way home.

All participants of the "GO GREEN" project appreciate the efforts, work and warm hospitality of the Spanish Third Mobility School. All participants find the activities very interesting and agree that they have learned a lot during the meeting.
