

Senior Ball Dress Code

Long and Short dresses. Strapless Spaghetti straps, halter, and backless no lower than the top of the arch of the back.



High slits above mid thigh. Costumes, blue jeans, athletic jackets, sweatshirts, shorts, Rompers, skorts, culottes.



Dresses fully lined and opaque fabric



Bodycon dresses. No plunging neckline. See through tops. Exposing of mid section or arch of The back.



Dress pumps or sandals



Casual, rubber shoes, sunglasses, caps



Dresses that are two pieces.



No cut-out mesh insets or sheer fabric anywhere between the armpit and hem.

Aloha or casual attire. Costumes, athletic Jackets, blue jeans, and sweatshirts.



Dress shoes and sandals



High tops, athletic shoes, rubber soled shoes moccasins, or slippers

Hats, caps, visors, shades



Personal wallet



Athletic bags
