

Dear Parents,

July 5 - 8

There will be NO DAY CAMP on Monday, July 4th, due to the holiday. Please make alternate arrangements for your child.

We will be traveling to the Brokenstraw Pool around Noon on **Tuesday, and Friday**. We will eat lunch at the pool. Campers will need a towel, sunscreen, swimming suit/trunks and spending money if they would like to purchase snacks at the concession stand. Please remind your child to ask for help with sunscreen if they need it. We will be back at The Salvation Army by 4:00.

On **Wednesday** we will be bowling in Sheffield at the Glow in the Dark Bowling Alley located at 22 Leather St. in Sheffield. Only half of the camp can be bowling at a time. So, we will be **loading the bus at 9:00 AM** and leaving by 9:15 AM for the **youngest group and half of the middle group**. The oldest group and other half of the middle group will stay at the building. The first group will be back at noon. For the **oldest group and the other half of the middle group**, we will be **loading the bus at 12. The bus will not wait for late comers**. Your child will be eating lunch during their time at the building. Please make sure you send a water bottle with them in addition to the drink in their lunch. Also, **make sure they are wearing socks** and know their shoe size for the bowling half of their day. There is food available for purchase (french fries seem to be the favorite), so please send money with your child if you would like them to be able to purchase a snack.

We will be spending **Thursday** at Waldameer Park and Water World. We will be leaving here at 9 am and returning by 6:30 pm. **Make sure you are here to pick up your child at 6:30 PM.** Do not make my staff wait for you to arrive...Everyone is tired and needs a break by then! If you're not scheduled for early drop off, **please have your child here by 8:45 am** as all staff will be here by 8:30am. We will be eating a picnic lunch there. Please send your child's lunch with them. **We recommend that you send extra money** on this field trip since we are there so long that they will at the very least, need a drink before it is all over and maybe something to eat too. Everything, concessions, souvenirs, games etc... are all done with Wally cards. This means that your child will put money on a card to use throughout the day;

they never expire, but they don't refund the money at the end of the day either. We will put part of your child's money on the card and then if they need more we will help them refill it. There are numerous machines throughout the park to do this at and our staff will help them decide how much they need throughout the day, but it probably won't be exact and your child may come home with a little money left on their card, so I just wanted to let you know up front. **Your child will need to wear his/her Day Camp T-shirt and bring a swimming suit, towel and sunscreen as well.** Your child will also need to bring sneakers for the regular park. Some rides require them to be permitted to ride.
