Other Research Opportunities

- Opportunities for Mentored Research
 - ➤ <u>SMURF Summer Mentored Undergraduate Research Fellowship</u> (Current first-year, sophomore, and junior students in any major can apply for up to \$5,000 for a full-time project. Students working on part-time SMURF awards may receive up to \$2,500.)
 - > NIH Undergraduate Scholarship Program (UGSP)
 - This program is for students from disadvantaged backgrounds who are committed to careers in biomedical, behavioral, and social science research. The program provides scholarship recipients up to \$20,000 per academic year for tuition, educational, and reasonable living expenses. Scholarships are awarded for one year and can be renewed for up to four years.
 - For every year of scholarship support, scholars commit to two paid service obligations in the NIH Intramural Research Program. These are:
 - A ten-week full-time summer internship at the NIH immediately following the year of scholarship support
 - One year of full-time work at the NIH post-graduation; this service obligation may be deferred until completion of an advanced degree program.
- Opportunities for Independent Research
 - ➤ <u>Kalorama Fellowship</u> (Current first-year, sophomore and junior students in the humanities, social sciences, and environmental sciences can apply for up to \$5,000. Students working on part-time Kalorama awards may receive up to \$2,500.)
 - ➤ <u>Lisa J. Raines Fellowship</u> (Current sophomore and junior students in any major can apply for up to \$5,000. Projects may be collaborative with two student researchers; if that is the case, each student on a collaborative project will receive up to \$2,500. Raines Fellows must attend a weekly summer seminar.)
- Royden B. Davis Fellowship offers summer fellowships which provide between \$1,500 and \$5,000 in summer support, depending upon the length of the proposed research/experience and the project budget (including the existence of other sources of funding)
